Sanford Area Community Resources

S3 Housing Connect seeks to bring together the needed resources in Sanford and Lee County to create a coordinated and comprehensive approach and to ensure that homelessness is prevented whenever possible, or is otherwise a rare, brief and non-recurring experience.

Our goal is to identify existing services and support for persons experiencing homelessness as well as gaps in those services and supports, and to bring those resources into a coordinated, community wide plan. The committee is tasked to focus on key areas such outreach and engagement with the unsheltered homeless; coordinated intake and assessment; prevention and diversion; and other social services. Included in this pamphlet are resources for individuals and families who are literally homeless, at imminent risk of homelessness (in danger of losing their shelter), or precariously housed (experiencing a situation that could lead to homelessness).
